You will already have received information on how other organisations manage your data on an ongoing basis under GDPR legislation. Whepstead Community Association is also bound by this legislation. The Committee have met and reviewed our approach to data handling. The following information serves to inform you how we will manage your data on an on-going basis.

Some of the reasons we may need to collect and hold your data

To hire the centre, for the provision of services, to distribute the Newsletter and to contact about community centre activities.

Types of information we may hold

- Name
- Email address
- Postal address
- Phone numbers (landline and mobile)
- Signature
- Bank account details
- Liability insurance details
- PAT testing certificates
- Disclaimers

Do we share your data to third party services?

We will never give your data to third parties. We will always make sure that your data is kept safe and secure.

What can you ask us to do?

At any time you can ask us to view, update or correct any data we hold on you. You can also ask that we stop using your data or that we erase it.
